60 - 65% of the water used in your family's home, is used in the bathroom. Each year, about \$220 is flushed down the drain, and about \$260 is used in the bath and shower.



70% of the earth's surface is covered with water, but only 1% is useable fresh water.



According to Environment Canada, the average Canadian uses 329 litres of water per day. Compare that to the average person living in a third world country, they only use 8 litres of water per day.



1,000 litres of tap water costs about \$2. The same amount of bottled water costs about \$1,500!
